## **PROPOSITION 08**

- I.3 DATE and DURATION (to be changed as follows, proposed by the ETTU EB and YC)
- I.3.1 The tournament shall be played each year between September and November, over a period of 3 days.

## **PROPOSITION 09**

- I.4 QUALIFICATION (to be changed as follows, proposed by the ETTU EB and YC)
- 1.4.3 **Qualified Participants:**
- I.4.3.1 Junior events: In each event the reigning European Junior Champion, and the 9 other highest ranked junior players, unless this does not include a player of the organising Association, in which case the host Association shall be entitled to nominate one of its players to replace the lowest ranked junior player.
  - If in the event, the reigning European Junior Champion is not eligible any longer, he/she shall be replaced by the first substitute.
  - The remaining place shall be allocated to the reigning cadet champion if he is no longer eligible in cadets or he/she shall be replaced by the first substitute.
- I.4.3.2 <u>Cadets events:</u> In each event the reigning European Cadet Champion, and the 9 other highest ranked cadet players, unless this does not include a player of the organising Association, in which case the host Association shall be entitled to nominate one of its players to replace the lowest ranked Cadet player.
  - If in the event, the reigning European Cadet Champion is not eligible any longer, he/she shall be replaced by the first substitute.
- I.4.4 The Associations of the first 3 boys and first 3 girls in the list of substitutes in each event shall arrange that these players can be contacted urgently to replace any of the qualified players who may be unable to attend.
- I.4.5 The General Secretary shall invite the qualified players and inform the reserve players of each event not later than 8 weeks before the start of the competition.
